

## Locust, Shademaster

*Gleditsia triacanthos 'Shademaster'*



<b>Classification</b>	Tree, Deciduous
<b>Height</b>	30' (9 m)
<b>Width</b>	45' (14 m)
<b>Color</b>	Green leaflets
<b>Flower Color</b>	Yellow, Green
<b>Flower Season</b>	Fall, Late Fall
<b>Sun</b>	Full Sun, Light Shade
<b>Soil</b>	Deep, moist, alkaline soil
<b>Climate Zones</b>	5,6,7,8
<b>Care Information</b>	

**Description** Shademaster Locust has small, leaflet foliage and grows about 2' or more a year. Because of its dense, and upright branches it makes a great shade tree. Fast growth rate.

---

## Boxwood, Green Mountain

*Buxus 'Green Mountain'*



<b>Classification</b>	Shrub, Evergreen Broadleaf
<b>Height</b>	5' (1.5 m)
<b>Width</b>	3' (90 cm)
<b>Color</b>	Dark green foliage
<b>Flower Color</b>	White
<b>Flower Season</b>	Spring, Late Spring
<b>Sun</b>	Full Sun, Full Shade, Light Shade
<b>Soil</b>	Well-drained, moist
<b>Climate Zones</b>	5,6,7,8,9
<b>Care Information</b>	

**Description** Upright pyramidal hybrid boxwood with small evergreen leaves that hold color through most winters. Protect from winter winds in northern climates. Inconspicuous creamy white flowers in spring. Shear or prune to shape early in growing season. Slow, uniform growth, good for hedge as well as formal specimen.

---

## Cypress, Boulevard (Pom Pon)

*Chamaecyparis pisifera 'Boulevard'*



<b>Classification</b>	Shrub, Evergreen Conifer
<b>Height</b>	15' (4.5 m)
<b>Width</b>	4' (1.2 m)
<b>Color</b>	Silvery- to gray-blue
<b>Flower Color</b>	Blue
<b>Flower Season</b>	Early Spring, Spring, Late Spring, Early Summer, Summer, Late Summer, Early Fall, Fall, Late Fall
<b>Sun</b>	Full Sun, Full Shade, Light Shade
<b>Soil</b>	Well-drained, moist, fertile
<b>Climate Zones</b>	4,5,6,7,8
<b>Care Information</b>	

**Description** Compact, dense, slow-growing evergreen shrub grown for a shapely garden feature. Fine-textured, plume-like foliage is light silvery blue-green, turning bronze in severe winters. Protect from drying winds. Clip in early spring to shape as desired. Use for accent in border, on patio.

---

## Azalea Stewart

*Rhododendron stewartianum*



<b>Classification</b>	Shrub, Evergreen Broadleaf
<b>Height</b>	8' (2.5 m)
<b>Width</b>	6' (1.8 m)
<b>Color</b>	Green and silvery
<b>Flower Color</b>	Red, Yellow, Pink, White
<b>Flower Season</b>	Spring
<b>Sun</b>	Full Shade, Light Shade
<b>Soil</b>	This plant will grow in dry soil.
<b>Climate Zones</b>	5, 6, 7
<b>Care Information</b>	Provide this plant with excellent drainage and organic soil. It is not salt tolerant or drought tolerant and does not do well to sweeping winter winds.

**Description** It has glossy, dark green foliage is evergreen, but turns reddish-chocolate in cold winters. Clusters of medium-sized, orange-red flowers appear in spring.

# Japanese Maple Bloodgood

*Acer palmatum 'Bloodgood'*



<b>Classification</b>	Tree, Deciduous
<b>Height</b>	15' (4.5 m)
<b>Width</b>	15' (4.5 m)
<b>Color</b>	Leaves deep red all summer, intensifies in fall
<b>Flower Color</b>	Yellow, White
<b>Flower Season</b>	Spring
<b>Sun</b>	Full Shade, Light Shade
<b>Soil</b>	Moist and well-drained; tolerates lime.
<b>Climate Zones</b>	5,6,7,8
<b>Care Information</b>	

**Description** Small, upright to rounded tree with distinctive leaves. Color intensifies in summer heat. Slow growing, rarely needs pruning. Cascading branches. Protect from cold winds. Use as accent, specimen or patio tree.

---

# Alocasia

*Colocasia esculenta*

<b>Care Information</b>	Average watering needs, needs warmth and high humidity.

**Description** Large purple and green heart shaped leaves.

## Viburnum 'Winterthur'

*Viburnum nudum 'Winterthur'*



<b>Classification</b>	Shrub, Deciduous
<b>Height</b>	8' (2.5 m)
<b>Width</b>	5' (1.5 m)
<b>Color</b>	Green foliage
<b>Flower Color</b>	White
<b>Flower Season</b>	Spring
<b>Sun</b>	Full Sun, Light Shade
<b>Soil</b>	Adaptable to most soils.
<b>Climate Zones</b>	5,6,7,8,9
<b>Care Information</b>	

**Description** 'Winterthur' is a compact cultivar featuring fragrant white flowers arranged in flat-topped clusters April-May. The flowers provide nectar for butterflies, native bees and other pollinators. Flowers are followed by clusters of rounded berries that change color as they ripen from light pink to deep pink to blue to purplish-black. Glossy dark green leaves turn maroon or dark red-purple in fall.

---

## Spruce, Alberta Spiral

*Picea glauca 'Conica'*



<b>Classification</b>	Shrub, Evergreen Conifer
<b>Height</b>	8' (2.5 m)
<b>Width</b>	4' (1.2 m)
<b>Color</b>	Green foliage
<b>Flower Color</b>	Tan
<b>Flower Season</b>	Spring, Late Spring
<b>Sun</b>	Full Sun, Light Shade
<b>Soil</b>	Adaptable to most soils.
<b>Climate Zones</b>	3,4,5,6,7,8
<b>Care Information</b>	

**Description** Alberta spruce is a compact tree with bright green needles. Excellent for foundation planting or as an accent plant. Slow growth rate.

---

## Chrysanthemum, Penny Lane

*Chrysanthemum x grandiflorum 'Penny Lane'*



<b>Classification</b>	Flower, Perennial
<b>Height</b>	24" (60 cm)
<b>Width</b>	2' (60 cm)
<b>Color</b>	Green foliage
<b>Flower Color</b>	Pink
<b>Flower Season</b>	Early Fall, Fall, Late Fall
<b>Sun</b>	Full Sun, Light Shade
<b>Soil</b>	Adaptable to most soils.
<b>Climate Zones</b>	5,6,7,8,9
<b>Care Information</b>	When new spring shoots are 6-8" long, pinch tips to encourage bushiness. Repeat pinching for later flowering varieties as needed until early summer when flower buds form. Cut tops to the ground after killing frost in fall, and apply winter mulch in cold areas. Divide in spring every 2-3 years.

**Description** Penny Lane is characterized by its light pink ray floret color and contrasting, generally dark orange disc florets.

---

## Azalea, Poukhanense

*Rhododendron yedoense var. poukhanense*



<b>Classification</b>	Shrub, Evergreen Broadleaf
<b>Height</b>	6' (1.8 m)
<b>Width</b>	4' (1.2 m)
<b>Color</b>	Green foliage
<b>Flower Color</b>	Red
<b>Flower Season</b>	Early Spring, Spring
<b>Sun</b>	Full Sun, Light Shade
<b>Soil</b>	Well-drained, moist, fertile
<b>Climate Zones</b>	5,6,7
<b>Care Information</b>	

**Description** The single, rounded white flowers are up to 3" across on this Girard hybrid Azalea. Its large, spreading habit makes it a great landscape Azalea. The green foliage is lighter than most other Girard types.

---

## Liriope, Aztec

*Liriope muscari 'Aztec'*



<b>Classification</b>	Flower, Perennial
<b>Height</b>	12" (30 cm)
<b>Width</b>	1' (30 cm)
<b>Color</b>	Blue
<b>Flower Color</b>	Blue
<b>Flower Season</b>	Summer
<b>Sun</b>	Full Shade, Light Shade
<b>Soil</b>	Well-drained, moist, humus-rich, acidic
<b>Climate Zones</b>	6,7,8,9,10
<b>Care Information</b>	

**Description** Short, dense spikes of flowers that follow with ornamental black fruit in the winter months. Great as a groundcover or edging in beds. Very dense and helps block out weeds.

---

## Butterfly Bush, Blue Chip

*Buddleja davidii 'Blue Chip' Lo & Behold*



<b>Classification</b>	Shrub, Deciduous
<b>Height</b>	36" (90 cm)
<b>Width</b>	
<b>Color</b>	Dark green foliage
<b>Flower Color</b>	Purple
<b>Flower Season</b>	Early Summer, Summer, Late Summer, Early Fall, Fall
<b>Sun</b>	Full Sun, Light Shade, Mostly Shade
<b>Soil</b>	Moist, well-drained and loamy.
<b>Climate Zones</b>	5,6,7,8,9
<b>Care Information</b>	

**Description** Arching shrub is semi-evergreen to evergreen in milder climates. Often killed to the ground in severe winters. Pointed leaves line stems which are topped by long, showy flower clusters. Flowers attract butterflies. Cut stems right back in early spring to remove dead parts and encourage fresh new growth. Grow in shrub border, as seasonal screen.
